WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Borough of Closter to treat employees and prospective employees in a manner consistent with all applicable employment laws and regulations including, but not limited to, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended by the Equal Opportunity Act of 1972, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act, the Equal Pay for Equal Work Act, the Fair Labor Standards Act, the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Family and Medical Leave Act, the Conscientious Employee Protection Act, the Public Employee Occupational Safety and Health Act, the New Jersey Workers Compensation Act, the Federal Consolidation Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) and the Open Public Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that there is a need for personnel policies and procedures to ensure that employees and prospective employees are treated in a manner consistent with these laws and regulations and has adopted same; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that in conjunction with and in addition to the personnel manual that an Employee Handbook be adopted and distributed to all employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Closter, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that the Employee Handbook (attached hereto as Exhibit A) is hereby adopted, shall be distributed to all employees by the Borough Administrator or his/her designee, and receipt thereof shall be signed by the aforementioned employees and returned to the Borough Administrator; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Handbook is intended to provide guidelines covering public service by Borough employees and is not a contract. The provisions of this Handbook may be amended and supplemented from time to time without notice and at the sole discretion of the Borough of Closter Governing Body. In the event there is a conflict between these policies and practices and any collective bargaining agreement, personnel services contract or Federal or State law, the terms and conditions of that contract or law shall prevail, but in all other cases, these policies and procedures shall prevail; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the maximum extent permitted by law, employment practices for the Borough shall operate under the legal doctrine known as "employment at will"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Administrator and all managerial/supervisory personnel are responsible for these employment practices. The Borough Administrator and the Borough Attorney shall assist the Governing Body in the implementation of the policies and procedures set forth in the Employee Handbook.

AR.S. 52:27BB-52 - AA local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) dollars or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.@
