RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REAL PROPERTY TAX REFUND TO DISABLED VETERAN JHOAN CHECO

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30 provides that the dwelling house and lot of any citizen and resident of New Jersey honorably discharged from active service, from any branch of the armed forces of the United States, who has been declared by the United States Veteran's Administration to have a 100% service-connected permanent disability, shall be exempt from real property taxation, on proper claim therefore; and

WHEREAS, Borough of Closter resident Jhoan Checo who owns and resides at Block 805 and Lot 47 also known as 89 Closter Dock Road, Closter, New Jersey, meets all the statutory criteria set forth above and who submitted to the Tax Assessor of the Borough of Closter a written declaration of 100% service-connected permanent disability by the United States Veterans Administration.

WHEREAS, as required by law the Borough of Closter Tax Assessor has exempted from real property taxes the aforementioned property owned by Mr. Checo at Block 805 Lot 47; aka 89 Closter Dock Road as of May 1, 2023.

WHEREAS, as per N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32, the Borough of Closter may at its discretion refund and return all taxes already collected on property which would have been exempt had proper claims in writing been made pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Closter has determined to exercise its discretion on the N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32 and refund taxes previously paid on behalf of Mr. Checo from Second Quarter 2023 in the amount of \$3,779.20 and establish the account exempt.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Closter authorizes the Tax Collectorto clear the real property taxes for Mr. Checo in the amount of \$3,779.20. the Tax Collector to clear the next bill from the rolls and the Mayor and the Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to sign same on behalf of the Borough of Closter.
