

Meeting Minutes

Monday, May 8, 2023 8:00 p.m. [held remotely via Zoom]

1. Call to Order—Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting was called to order at 8:03 pm

Chairman Abate will engage Kevin Whitney on the latter option.

Ms. Lockhart reviewed information provided by Mr. Paschalis regarding \$2.5 million in grant funding available to local Schools. The program is sponsored by DEP, Sustainable Jersey, and the College of New Jersey and offers funding (no match required) to plant trees on school district or municipal land that students frequent (including along streets). An informational webinar will be held on May 18, 2023. The Commission agreed this application would be worthwhile to support.
