Closter's Memorial Day Parade and Service:

It is with tremendous pride that the Leroy S. Mead Post 111 American Legion, the Closter Elks Lodge 2304 and the Borough of Closter are hosting the 2016 Memorial Day Parade and Memorial Service on Monday, May 30, 2016. With respect and in honor of the 18 Closter residents who gave the ultimate sacrifice in World War I, World War II and Vietnam, as well as those residents who are currently serving our Country, the 2016 Memorial Day Schedule of Events is as follows:

8:30 a.m. Leroy S. Mead Post 111, American Legion Memorial Service Veterans Monument Park, Herbert Avenue & Closter Dock Road

9:00 a.m. Closter Fire Department Service 100 Ruckman Road

10:00 a.m. Memorial Day Parade

Participants assemble at 9:30 a.m. in the St. Mary's Church parking area; The parade steps off at 10:00 a.m.

Route: The parade begins on Legion Place at High Street, continues east on High St. to Closter Dock Rd., bearing left; then proceeds north on Closter Dock Rd., then West onto Harrington Avenue, concluding at Veteran's Memorial Park

The Memorial Day Ceremony is held on the north side of Veteran's Memorial Park and begins immediately following the conclusion of the parade. Please join in the community's spirit and commitment in honoring the service men and women of our Armed Forces by lining the streets along the parade route and displaying American flags. Residents are invited to the Closter Elks for refreshments following the Memorial Day Ceremony.

Mollicone Park Rededication

A ceremony rededicating the memorial to Lt. Donald A. Mollicone, a Borough resident who sacrificed his life in the Vietnam War, will be held on Sunday, May 29 at 12 noon in the Closter park that bears his name. Jason Lee, 17, who recently achieved the rank of Eagle Scout, refurbished Lt. Mollicone's memorial as his Eagle Scout Project. Three new commemorative kiosks, a flagpole and a walk-in area for visitors to view the kiosks are major elements of the memorial. Jason enlisted the help of local businesses as well as fellow Boy Scouts to help him refurbish and build the structures. Please join the Borough of Closter in this important event.
