

BOROUGH OF CLOSTER
ORDINANCE NO.: 2016:1202
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER 183 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLOSTER,
SPECIFICALLY, SECTION 183-45

WHEREAS, the Borough of Closter desires to amend Chapter 183 of the Code of the Borough of Closter, Vehicles and Traffic, specifically §183-45, No Parking, Certain Hours; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the health and safety residents of the Borough to amend this section of the Code; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended and approved the changes; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance and Legislative Committee has reviewed the changes and recommend adoption of same; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Attorney has reviewed the changes and found same to be in order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Closter, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1.

Add Paragraph E to §183-45, Schedule II:

E. Up to 14 spaces in the Borough Hall parking lot (located at Block 1309, Lot 3 on the Borough’s Tax Map) shall be designated by the posting of signs as parking for Borough Employees and for Visitors to the Borough Hall on Borough Business, during regular business hours, 8:30 – 4:30, Monday through Friday (Borough holidays excluded). The Chief of Police, with the advice and consent of the Mayor and Counsel, shall determine the parking spaces which shall be so designated. It shall be illegal for persons who are not Borough Employees or who are not visiting on Borough Business to park in these designated spaces during aforementioned days and times.

Section 2.

If any sentence, section, clause or other portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall, for any reason, be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or repeal the remainder of this Ordinance. All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
